

Unless you purchased SHIPPING during sign-up, we ask you to attend Packet Pickup to get your RIK.

Riders with a VIP Pass or Ride Pass + Jersey get FREE shipping included with their passes.

Packet Pickup WILL NOT be available on Saturday.

Access the Start Line Corrals on Benjamin Frankling Parkway through N 21st St. and N 22nd St. coming from Race St. or Pennsylvania Avenue / Callowhill St.

7:30 AM • RIDE BEGINS

8:15 AM • FINISH FESTIVAL STARTS

12:30 PM • FINISH FESTIVAL ENDS

Rider Identification Kit (RIK)

Riders must be wearing their RIK to participate in the Ride.

Your bib number must be attached to the front of your shirt, and the helmet sticker must be worn on your helmet.

Unless you purchased shipping or signed up as a VIP rider or Ride Pass + Jersey rider, **you must attend packet pickup** to get your Rider Identification Kit (RIK) in advance.



AT PACKET PICKUP, you'll receive your water bottle and rider identification kit (RIK), which includes a paper bib number you must pin to the front of your shirt and a helmet sticker you must stick to the front of your helmet.

The Packet Pickup is open to all! Come through to get ready for the ride and enjoy giveaways from partners and special offers at the Philly Bike Ride Pop-Up Shop.

ALL RIDERS MUST HAVE THEIR RIK IN PLACE TO ENTER THE START CORRALS AT THE EVENT

Eakins Oval is located 1 mile away from Fairmount, Spring Garden and Race-Vine subway stations.

We recommend carpooling or biking to Packet Pickup - we'll have bike parking onsite. Driving to the area? Parking near the Oval can be challenging. Check the many garages available within half-mile for more options.

CAN'T ATTEND PACKET PICKUP?

SEND A PROXY TO GET YOUR RIK

If you didn't purchase Shipping during sign-up and cannot attend Packet Pickup, you MUST send a proxy to get your RIK.

You don't need to notify us about sending a proxy on your behalf.
All we ask from your proxy is to show a photo of your ID or confirmation number.

No ID is required for riders under 18.

GETTING TO THE START

THE PHILLY BIKE RIDE START LINE IS POWERED BY



LOCATION: Benjamin Franklin Parkway, between N 20th St. and N 22nd St.



- Corrals can be accessed from N 21st St. and N 22nd St. via Pennsylvania Ave/Callowhill St. and via Race St.
- The best time to arrive is before 6:30 AM, but please plan to arrive at the corrals entrance no later than 7:00 AM in order to be in your start corral by 7:15 AM.
- Routes on the drop-off zone highlighted in the map should be open during Philly Bike Ride but all road closures are subject to change at the discretion of public safety officers.

Make sure to plan your trip to the Start Line ahead of time for a stress-free morning!



BIKE TO THE START

If you want to add a couple of miles to your route, we suggest you bike to the start! We mapped out some routes from locations around the region just for you.

USING SEPTA

There are three stations located less than one mile away from the Philly Bike Ride Start Line: Fairmount, Spring Garden, and Race-Vine subway stations. Make sure to plan ahead and check what time SEPTA starts running at your departure station and the ETA to your preferred station of arrival.



PARKING RECOMMENDATIONS


Parking nearby the event venue can be challenging, and we recommend booking a parking spot in advance to park in one of the several parking garages within 0.5 miles of the event area.





START LINE DETAILS

At the Ride Start area, on Benjamin Franklin Pkwy between N 20th St. and N 22nd St., you will see corral entrance signs that read **BEGINNER**, **INTERMEDIATE**, **ADVANCED**, and **VIP**. These signs designate the Start Corrals where you will line up for the Start Line. **Your corral reflects the type of bicyclist you identify as and your biking level or ability**.

Please do not switch corrals and allow some space between participants while lined up inside your preferred corral. The VIP corral will be released first, followed by Advanced, Intermediate, and then Beginner.



Riders who are **DEAF OR HARD-OF-HEARING** are welcome to meet at the Start Line Stage (near the star symbol) where there'll be an interpreter. Riders in this group do not need to enter the corrals. For other accommodations please email us at **HELLO@PHILLYBIKERIDE.COM**

BIKE RENTALS

RENTAL PICKUP DETAILS


At the **Unlimited Biking Tent**, located on **the south side of Eakins Oval**.

Rentals will be available for pick up on **SATURDAY**, 10/19, FROM 6:00 AM TO 7:00 AM.

The schedule allows riders enough time to bike from Rental Pickup to the Start Line.

NO BIKE? NO PROBLEM! Our Rent & Ride program offers the Ride Pass bundled with bike and helmet rentals for ride day. Rentals can also be reserved during sign-up by riders who select other ticket types.

The last day to sign up with bike rentals is October 15, and riders can also book rentals directly with the Unlimited Biking team.



RENTAL PICKUP STEPS + NOTES

- Present your Philly Bike Ride and Unlimited Biking confirmations at the Bike Rental Pickup tent.
 Riders who reserved rentals will receive a confirmation from Unlimited Biking by October 17.
 Bikes will not be handed out until ALL members of the party are present and accounted for.
- Pollow the route indicated in the map above to bike 0.3 miles to enter your preferred corral.
- Return your bike to the Unlimited Biking Team at the same spot to close out your rental.

 Please DO NOT leave your bike on the racks or bike parking.

REST STOPS/WATER STATIONS

Fully stocked rest stops with water, bananas, and other snacks will be available along the way on **Miles 8.5 and 15.5.**



BATHROOMS

Portable toilets are available at all **Rest Stops**, **Start Line**, and **Finish Festival**.



MEDICAL HELP

Our main medical hub will be placed by the Finish Line. ASK ANY STAFF MEMBER, VOLUNTEER OR POLICE OFFICER IF YOU NEED MEDICAL ASSISTANCE.



SAG VEHICLES (SUPPORT AND GEAR)

SAG vehicles provide transportation to the Finish Line for riders (and their bikes) who require assistance or are behind the 6 MPH pace.



BIKE REPAIR & FREE TUNE-UPS

Mobile Mechanics will be at the Start Line area and on-course to assist riders during the event. If you get a flat tire or have a mechanical issue with your bicycle, look for a Mobile Mechanic.

Keswick Cycle will be at the Start Line, providing bike safety checks.



Course Highlights include

Shake Shack Stop on Mile 14 and the

Red Bull DJs on Miles 11 and 16.





ASSISTANCE AND EMERGENCIES

If you need assistance, medical attention or if your bike has a major mechanical issue, and you need transportation to the Finish Festival, contact our Ride Support Staff during the ride at (215) 606-3562. In case of critical medical emergency, call 911.

GETTING READY TO RIDE

BEFORE THE RIDE

Plan your trip to the Start Line in advance. Check travel time and reserve parking in advance.

Check your bicycle prior to the event to ensure you have air in your tires, working brakes, and any quick releases tightened.

RIDING WITH KIDS AND TEENS

Children under the age of 3 are NOT allowed on the ride.

Kids (ages 3-7) must ride with an adult on a tandem bike, in a child's seat, on a tag-along bike or in a bike trailer.

Youth riders (ages 8-17) must participate in the event with an **adult riding in closing proximity** the entire event.

RIDING AS A GROUP/TEAM

Pick a **meeting spot** at the Start Line area prior to entering the ride corrals.

Make sure you and others in your group have stored important **contact info.**

If you get separated from your group, continue to the next rest stop and look for them there. For safety, do NOT pull over to the side of the






RULES OF THE RIDE

- **1 WEAR YOUR HELMETS!** Helmets are mandatory and required to participate in the ride. If you're not wearing a helmet, you will not be permitted to join the ride.
- 2 HAVE YOUR RIDER IRENTIFICATION KIT (RIK) VISIBLE at all times. Affix your bib to your shirt and helmet sticker on the front of your helmet. You may be asked to leave the ride if elements of your RIK are missing.
- 3 RESPECT OTHER CYCLISTS AND KEEP A SAFE DISTANCE between yourself and others around you.
- 4 DO NOT RIDE AGAINST THE FLOW, NOR STOP IN THE MIDDLE OF THE ROAD. Move completely to the side of the road (right side) and look for a safe place before stopping along the route.
- **5** DO NOT WEAR EAR BUDS OR HEADPHONES.
- 6 Keep at least ONE HAND ON THE HANDLEBARS at all times.

- **BE PREDICTABLE AND RIDE IN A STRAIGHT LINE.** Keep to the right side of the roadway when riding and pass other riders on the left side of the roadway.

 Call out "passing on your left" if you have to pass slower riders closely and use hand signals when slowing down, stopping, turning or changing lanes.
- 8 DO NOT USE YOUR PHONE while biking. If you wish to take pictures during the ride (which is highly encouraged), pull over to the side of the road so other riders don't get blocked. Share your photos on social media and tag @PhillyBikeRide.
- **9 CONTROL YOUR SPEED** and be ready to slow down for congestion or road hazards.
- 10 E-BIKE POLICY: The Ride welcomes class 1, 2 and 3 e-bikes. Riders must comply with the speed limit of 18 mph and are not allowed to exclusively use the motor without pedaling for an extended period of time.


